Oklahoma City, May 4, 2011 -- A moving and poignant celebration of Oklahoma, "Shooting from the Hip" is a new collection of photography by renowned Oklahoma photojournalist J. Don Cook. The longtime photographer, artist and poet will sign copies of the book 3pm-5pm Saturday, May 28, at Full Circle Bookstore in Oklahoma City.

With a foreword by James Garner and published by University of Oklahoma Press, "Shooting from the Hip" is a dazzling valentine to Cook's native state. Its black-and-white photos and short essays reflect Oklahoma's singular character, warmth and charm.

A 23-year veteran photojournalist, Cook has been nominated three times for a Pulitzer Prize and was named News Photographer of the Year three times by the Oklahoma Press Association. His work has appeared in such publications as National Geographic, Time and Life.
